
Jurassic Fibre

About us

- Jurassic Fibre is rolling out a new ultrafast full-fibre internet broadband network to connect communities across the South-West.
- Backed with an initial investment of £250m from Fern Trading Limited, we plan to build over 500,000 premises across Cornwall, Devon, Dorset and Somerset by 2025. Jurassic Fibre connects people in difficult locations that other companies won't go to.
- Jurassic Fibre is now one of the biggest employers in the region with over 480 staff and headquarters based in Exeter.
- In February 2023 Fern Trading Limited announced that it is consolidating Jurassic Fibre, Swish Fibre, Giganet/Cuckoo and AllPoints Fibre into a single Fibre To The Premises (FTTP) operator.
- Business as usual whilst consolidation takes place.



What is FTTP (Fibre-to-the-Premises) and why do I need it?




- Copper cables slow down speeds significantly and performance can be affected by factors such as:
 - the weather.
 - electrical interference.
 - distance from the exchange/cabinet.
 - the number of users on the network.

The copper network will be retired in the future.
- Ultrafast full-fibre broadband speeds mean that what would take sometimes hours to download on old-fashioned copper broadband can be achieved in minutes.
- Jurassic Fibre customers are enjoying speeds of up to 1Gbps – which means even the ‘super streamers’ using multiple devices, watching films, gaming and downloading huge files, can enjoy fast, reliable broadband.
- FTTP can run both broadband and telephone requirements.
- Jurassic Fibre’s work today will future-proof regional businesses and homes for tomorrow.

Build Approach

- We build and manage our own state-of-the-art network 24/7.
- Our build methodology is based on creating core rings to join our PoP (Point of Presence) sites – our equivalent of a BT Exchange. This ensures complete resiliency across any part of our network.
- Our PoP Sites tend to be located in towns from which we build using an ‘inside-out’ type approach to firstly cover the town and continue to extend outwards into some of the hardest to reach and most rural locations.
- We currently have 30 live PoP sites, including Seaton, Bridport, Sidmouth and Exmouth.
- Whilst we are deploying our own brand-new network, we extensively use existing Poles and Ducts wherever possible. This allows us to build quicker and with less disruption. However, there will still be occasions where a road closure will be required.




